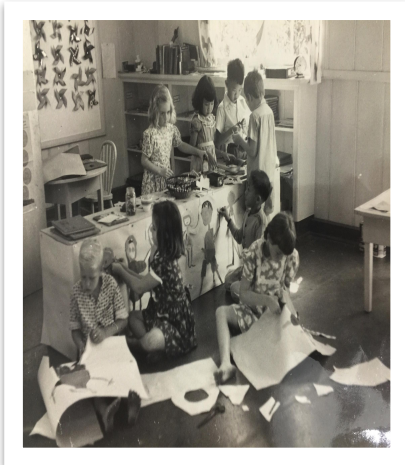

Near-Term

Make the spaces safe and secure.

1911 Ke'eaumoku Street

- Create an open green space for children to play
- Create 12 parking stalls for employees and overflow parking (33) for events

1921 Ke'eaumoku Street

- Make existing structure safe for learning


1931 Ke'eaumoku Street

- Use existing structure for storage



Improvements Completed

1911 Ke'eaumoku Street

- Removed unsafe, dilapidated structures
 - Removed debris, including inoperable cars (~ 12)
 - Remediated soil
 - Secured the perimeter
 - Addressed stormwater drainage
 - Graded the lot
 - Installed irrigation, sod, landscaping to mitigate dust and stabilize the land
 - Created 12 parking spaces for employees

Improvements Completed

1921 Ke'eaumoku Street

- Trimmed trees
- Removed debris
- Working on creating a green space
- Secured structure to deter vagrants
- Submitted building permit for safety improvements and renovations – i.e. removing interior walls, installing new roof, painting, etc.

- Removed unsafe, dilapidated structure
- Trimmed trees
- Removed debris
- Secured structure to deter vagrants
- Using for storage

We have no long-range plan.

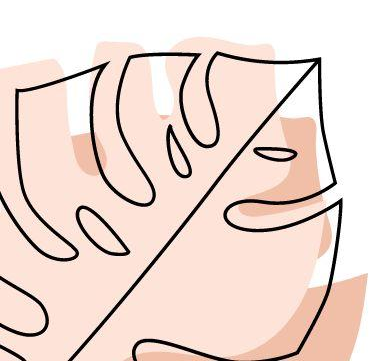
In the next couple of years, we hope to begin a master campus planning process.

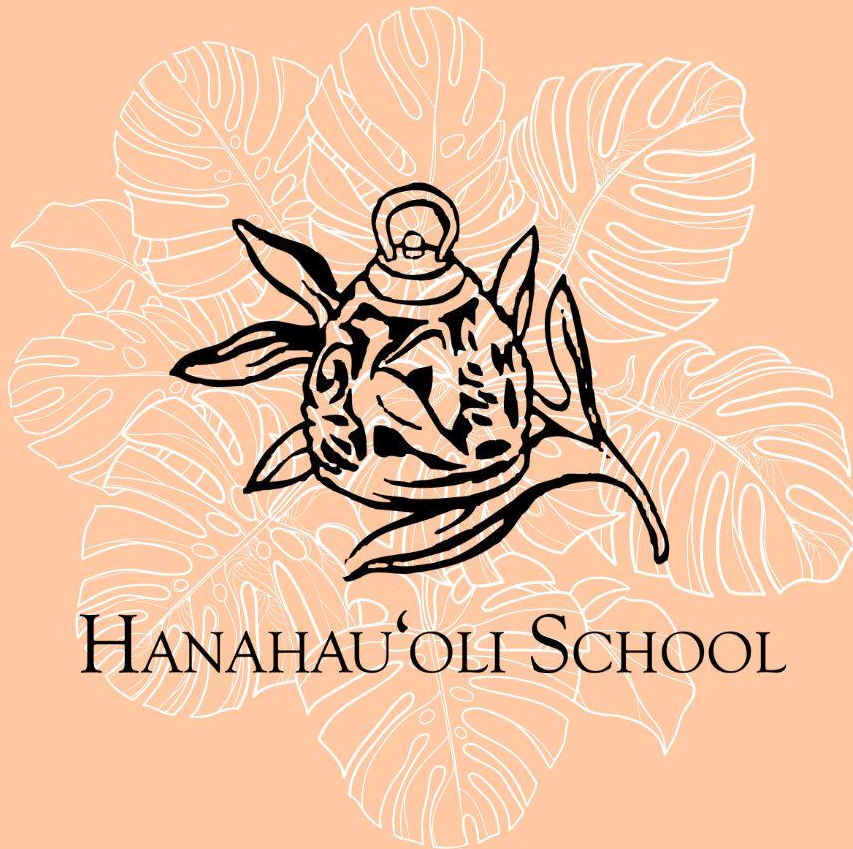
